TSD RALLIES

DISCUSSION

- Trail of Gnu ran, well attended by ERC. Great event.
- Mudlark Looks like it's going to be great. May 7th, in Calgary
- Loon July 10th. Will need a committee to come and help set up, as well as help running the event. Will be part of the Rallywest TSD championship. Mike Elhard recommends using the same route as last year. Lots of leased roads out towards Drayton that could be used.

CONCLUSIONS

Committee required to plan, and run, the Loon, as it's an important event for the club and our reputation within CARS and the rally community.

RALLYCROSS

DISCUSSION

- Well attended at least 20 people at every event, except Team Challenge #2.
- Weekend event at Castrol, very good feedback, ran an eliminator. Everyone paddocked inside. Helped get marshals into the field, more people watching. 25 entries. Marcel has all the timing equipment and will get the scoreboard going for us, and battery packs to not have to use the AA batteries in the system. Does anyone know the axe wear log in? No one time use. Could purchase a new copy of the software if we needed to.
- Long track at Roy's was fun, too bad about the weather.
- Bill's field is dry and workable at this point, but is likely still soft this week so it could be left for another week or two to get it really dry. Someone at the weekend event said they might have access to a grader. Also getting a quote from Rob Reeves. Will be putting together a sponsorship request, please distribute as possible once it's available.
- Elhard had some concerns about the last event. Control of the site. Bus in the centre was not a good idea. Concern about the track running clockwise, using small gates. Why are we with CARS? WCMA has fewer rules, but we could not use the term Rallycross.
- Safety is important, as we don't want any injuries.
- Could we paint around the pylons so they can be replaced correctly in the future? We could look into that road marking paint for the next event
- April 30th as a possible event date Night race under the lights, BBQ before, help piggy back on the NASCC race school. This will be our last chance to use the track, as Castrol will be starting their preparation in May, depending on their track walk this coming Monday. They are expecting to start disking and compacting later this week/next week. There will be divots due to that process, but we have run on that before. Could be issues with tire wear. Some members concerned about tire wear.
- There are more opportunities at Castrol in the future, after the summer season.
- Do we cancel the May event? There's a potential to saturate the market, or burn people out. Yes, we cancel the May event.

CONCLUSIONS

- There have been a few offers of used laptops to be donated, but we would either have to reuse the same harddrive or rebuy the Axeware that we use for timing. Alternately, manually create spreadsheets and manually input times off RaceAmerica system.
- Elhard had some concerns about safety at the event after watching some online videos. These concerns have been noted and will be taken into consideration for next event at Castrol.
- Bill's field is dry and workable, but could use another week or two to continue to dry out/warm up. Field needs work done before any events are held there.
- May event cancelled due to it being held on Mother's Day, and not having a venue.
- Many of the attendees at the meeting decided that the concern of tire wear after Castrol has been compacted is too significant to run an event on April 30th.

FINANCES

DISCUSSION

- \$2499 currently in the bank.
- Bus payment, insurance, bus inspection, and venue rental still to come out.
- No event in May means that we'll have very little money in a very short time.
- Could ask the NASCC for the rental payment upfront. Rental agreement for the trailer still needs to be done

CONCLUSIONS

- Very little cash available to the club currently, with no income in May.
- Could ask NASCC for rental payment in advance of the season.

TIMING BUS

DISCUSSION

- Bus receiving an inspection on Monday, as per the Board's decision. Bus is currently leaking fluid and needs front end work, so it cannot be taken to Bill's in current condition.

- Seats still need to be mounted, and a counter built before it's taken to Bill's for storage.
- Bill will charge us to store the bus in his RV lot, as it will not be parked near the seacan (too visible, attractive asset).

CONCLUSIONS

- The bus will be inspected on Monday, April 18th
- Complete inventory needs to be done volunteers requested.
- Work on bus (and associated budget) needs to be completed.
- Once work is done, bus will be stored at Bill's, for a fee.
